Dress Code for Grades 7-12

2016-2017

The purpose of a dress code is to promote a learning environment free from distraction. Parental support is a key factor in enforcement. Thank you for your assistance as you sign the dress code statement on the contract.

FACS administration will make the final determination on the appropriateness of any clothing, accessories, hairstyles, and colors worn to school or any school sponsored event.

Gentlemen:

Pants / Shorts All items must be purchased at Dennis Uniforms. Belts are required. All pants / shorts should fit properly and must be worn near the waist. Shorts must be to the knee. No patches, frayed or cut hems, tears or holes are allowed.

Shirts / Sweaters All items must be purchased at Dennis Uniforms. All oxford style shirts and excessively long polo or rugby style shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Jackets / Coats Dennis Uniforms outerwear items and approved FACS jackets, sweaters, and sweatshirts may be worn. Coats, jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters which contain acceptable designer, college, and professional sports logos may be worn as well. A Dennis Uniforms shirt must be worn under all outerwear items. All Victoria's Secret and Abercrombie & Fitch logos are specifically forbidden.

Shoes / Socks Shoes must be closed toe. If the shoe has laces they must be tied. No flip-flops, sandals, or beachwear allowed. Shoes must be worn at all times during the school day.

Hair Hair must be cut in such a way that at least half of the ear can be seen. It must be off the eyebrows, and must not extend below the collar of an oxford shirt. Sideburns cannot extend below the earlobe. Neatly trimmed mustaches and chin beards are acceptable. Proper hairstyles and colors are required.

Jewelry / Body Art One necklace allowed. No chain belts or chain wallets. No visible tattoo or body piercing is permitted (includes all school functions).

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Ladies:

Skirts / Kilts All items must be purchased at Dennis Uniforms and worn to the top of the knees. Girls must wear black or white tights, black or white mid-calf length leggings, or shorts under their skirts.

Slacks / Capris All items must be purchased at Dennis Uniforms. Belts must be worn with visible belt loops. All slacks and capris should fit properly and must be worn near the waist. Capris must extend below the knee. No patches, frayed or cut hems, tears or holes are allowed.

Blouses / Shirts/ Sweaters All items must be purchased at Dennis Uniforms.

Jackets / Coats Dennis Uniforms outerwear items and approved FACS jackets and sweatshirts may be worn. Coats, jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters which contain acceptable designer, college, and professional sports logos may be worn as well. A Dennis Uniforms shirt must be worn under all outerwear items. All Victoria's Secret and Abercrombie & Fitch logos are specifically forbidden.

Shoes / Socks Shoes must be closed toe. If the shoe has laces they must be tied. No flip-flops, sandals, or beachwear allowed. Heels may not be worn with skirts. Shoes must be worn at all times during the school day.

Hair Hair must be styled and colored appropriately.

Jewelry / Body Art No visible tattoo or body piercing is permitted except ears. Ears may have no more than two (2) earrings per ear.

Special Notes for all Students: No hats, caps, fatigues, camouflage, tie-dye, sunglasses, New Age jewelry, and satanic or other anti-Christian symbols allowed.

Exception:

- Jeans and FACS T-shirts will be allowed only on special days announced in advance.

****If abused, FACS administration may revoke these privileges, corporately or individually, at any time.***

Dress Code violations may result in students being asked to sit in a designated area until appropriate clothing is brought to the school by family or friends. Class time missed for this reason may be unexcused and negatively affect grades. Repeated and / or flagrant violations may jeopardize continued enrollment.
