After-School Policy, Grades 7-12
2017-2018

1. Students in grades 7-12 who are not involved in extra-curricular activities and who must remain on the campus after 3:45 PM will be required to go to the first floor of the 8636 building. Students will not be allowed on the second floor.
2. FACS staff will be on duty until 6:00 PM to monitor student activity in this area. Students will be allowed to enjoy a snack, work on homework, read, play board games, visit quietly together, use their technology, or engage in any other acceptable activity.
3. Students will not be required to sign in and parents will not have to sign their children out. There are no fees for this service. However, all students in this category must report to the 8636 building by 3:45 PM.
4. Repeated failure to pick up the student by 6:00 PM, unacceptable behavior, destruction of school property, and/or disrespect toward the FACS staff will result in a student's loss of privilege to participate in the program.
5. FACS and its employees will not be held responsible for the safety and security of students who deliberately refuse to report to the 8636 building by the designated time, who leave the 8636 building before they are picked up, or who leave the 8636 building with someone other than their parent(s).
6. No FACS staff will be on duty in the 8636 building after 6:00 PM for this purpose, nor may students remain on campus on the days when school is dismissed at 11:30 AM or 12:00 pm.
