## Summer Fun Mini-Camps

**Registration ends two weeks prior to the first day of each mini-camp.**

Make sure the camp(s) you choose are age appropriate for your child.

Registration forms must be completed, signed, and returned **with deposit** before registration of a camp is complete. Put forms and deposit in an envelope addressed to Summer Fun Mini-Camps/Merilyn Turman. The remaining payment is due on the first day of camp. Make payments to FACS with cash, check, or money order. Camps will be filled on a first come, first served basis. **(The deposit reserves your spot and is non-refundable unless the camp is cancelled due to lack of interest and you will be notified as soon as possible.)**

Campers must be in good health and able to participate in all activities listed in the enrolled camp. Required medication must be administered at home before arriving for camp session. Any exceptions will require guardian consent and a written doctor's order to be on file with medication and a written care plan for children with asthma or severe allergies.

FACS Summer Fun Mini-Camps reserve the right to cancel any mini-camp session that does not meet minimum enrollment requirements. Also, we reserve the right to dismiss campers displaying disruptive or unsafe behavior with no refunds.
