In order for your child to be enrolled in dual enrollment at First Assembly Christian School, he or she must also enroll in the University of Memphis. We at FACS have streamlined this process for you and will collect the following information in order to hand deliver all applications for the class(es) together.

Please understand that dual enrollment is a college course and as such is subject to university rules for attendance, grades, withdrawing, etc. Students must meet the ACT requirements for admission to the University of Memphis.

Grades for the college are submitted before final semester grades for FACS are due and therefore may reflect a different average from the high school semester average.

Students will be required to purchase textbook(s) and pay any additional lab fees.

Tuition is \$385.00 per semester with the TSAC grant covering \$300.00 of that cost upon completion of grant application. While students earn 3 hours of credit per semester for a 2.0 or above, students **must** earn a cumulative 2.75 GPA in all DE course work for the first semester in order to retain grant eligibility.
