All tuition and fees are non-refundable.  
Enrollment fee increases by \$25 as of March 1.

- Fee of \$40 for science classes, \$35 for home economics classes, \$75 for computer classes, and \$20 for visual art, film and video classes, and theatre.
- Standardized test fee of \$30 (grades 7-10). ACT test fee of \$50-55 depending on rates set by ACT (grade 11).
- A technology fee of \$240 per year accommodates all students in grades 9-11 with laptop computers. Fee is due by July 1. More information regarding the technology fee may be found at facsmemphis.org.
- All new students in grades 7-12 needing the assistance of the Student Support Services Department will be charged \$25 for the Brigance Comprehensive Inventory of Basic Skills II test.
- Students in grades 7-12 who do not participate in the Resource Program but need an Individual Education Plan (IEP) from Student Support Services for accommodations in the regular classroom setting will be assessed a fee of \$200.
- Late payment fee of \$45 is assessed after the first day of each month; an additional late payment fee of \$30 is assessed after the tenth day of each month.
- Returned check fee is \$30.
- Senior graduation fee is \$125.
- Tuition may be paid annually, semi-annually, or on a ten-month plan. Annual tuition is due August 1, semi-annual is due August 1 and January 1, and monthly is due the first of every month from August-May.
- Athletic fees: each sport \$100, football \$200.
- Online credit/debit card payments made through NetClassroom will incur a 2.65% convenience fee. No additional fees are incurred for bank draft payments.

## SPARKS (SrK-6) & RESOURCE/STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES (7-12)

- This program includes reading intervention in grades 1-6 and math intervention in grades 3-6. Methodology includes individualized and small-group instruction. NOTE: SPARKS is introduced on a limited basis at no additional cost during the second semester of SrK.

## RESOURCE/STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES (GRADES 7-12)

- Resource classes for secondary students are offered through Student Support Services. See fees above. There is limited space in our Resource classes (7-12).

### IMPORTANT (FOR NEW ENROLLMENT ONLY\*)

- **A fee of \$50 is paid with online application.**
- **The enrollment fee is paid online after notification of acceptance; the school contract is signed online at that time.**
- **First month's tuition is paid during a personal meeting with the Director of Admissions after notification of acceptance.**

\*The above does not apply to those who are re-enrolling.

## DISCOUNTS

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- Multiple child monthly discount: second child \$10, third child \$20, fourth child \$30, fifth child \$40.
- Tuition Incentive Program: Total annual tuition paid by August 1 will qualify for 5% discount. Total semi-annual tuition paid by August 1 and January 1 will qualify for 2.5% discount.
- 5% Military and First Responder Discount: for enrolled children of full time (minimum 30 hours) military, law enforcement and first responders.
- Referral Fee Discount: for every new student referred by a currently enrolled student, and assuming the referred student remains at FACS for one year and has an up-to-date tuition payment account, the referring parent will receive a discount on their child's tuition. The discount is up to \$1000 (for full-pay students). Referral amount may be reduced proportionately for referral of students on tuition assistance.
- Church discount of \$10 monthly for students who have parents that regularly attend and are members in good standing of First Assembly Memphis.

## COMPLIMENTARY BENEFITS

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- Tuition includes a student yearbook and student entrance into all regular-season home games.

# Early Drop-Off/After-School Care

FACS offers early drop-off and after-school care as an added service to provide a safe, convenient and economical program before and after school hours for the children of working parents and guardians.

## EARLY DROP-OFF

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On full days of school, the operating hours for early drop-off are from 7:00-7:45 am. This service is free of charge.

## AFTER-SCHOOL CARE

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After-school care is available until 5:45 pm for elementary students. There is an additional charge for this service. Our program does not provide after-school care on half days, teacher in-service days, or school holidays. After-school care enrollment forms must be on file before the first day of this service.

FACS personnel will be on duty in the 8636 Building from 3:30-6:00 pm each day to monitor students in grades 7-12 waiting to be picked up. There is an additional charge for this service. Our program does not provide after-school care on half days, teacher in-service, or school holidays.

## IMPORTANT NOTE

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It is school policy that all children be either off school grounds, involved in FACS-sponsored activities (athletics/fine arts/clubs) or in after-school care by 3:15 pm (elementary students) or in the 8636 Building by 3:45 pm (junior/senior high students). *Coaches and teachers will not be responsible for siblings of students participating in sports or other school-related activities.*
